SECTION L

FORMAL FLORAL ART

All flowers to be grown by the exhibitor.

VASES AND BOWLS: Exhibitors may use their own vases or bowls or may use those provided by the Society.

DEFINITIONS:

Vase: greater in height than in diameter.

Bowl: of equal diameter and height or greater in diameter than height.

All vases and bowls must conform to a circle and any container which does not come within these definitions is not a vase or bowl.

CLASS

1. Vase of Flowering Shrub
2. Vase of Gerberas, own foliage
3. Vase of Chrysanthemums
4. Vase of Roses, not exceeding 12 cuts
5. Vase of flowers, one or more variety, any foliage allowed
6. Bowl of Roses – Any Type
7. Bowl of Autumn Foliage, berries allowed
8. Bowl of Mixed Flowers, any foliage allowed
9. Bowl of Flowers, one

SECTION M

INFORMAL FLORAL ART

Exhibits may be brought to the hall complete

Flowers not necessarily grown by exhibitor

Maximum space allowed in any one class will be approximately 75cm square

No artificial flowers. No other restrictions unless otherwise specified.
