ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE IN THE HALL BETWEEN  
8AM & 12 NOON THURSDAY 9<sup>th</sup> APRIL

Every exhibit must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor and must have been produced or made by the exhibitor.

Any article which has been exhibited at a previous Kalamunda Show will not be eligible to compete.  
In plain and fancy needlework, exhibits must be unwashed, and all edges must be hand worked.  
A crochet edge is permissible on knitted articles.

### CLASS

1. Hand knitted child or adult garment
2. Hand knitted baby's garment/s
3. Any other hand knitted article
4. Crocheted adult or child garment
5. Crocheted baby's garment/s
6. Crocheted shawl, stole or poncho
7. Amigurumi Item/Items (Up to 10 pieces)
8. Any other crocheted article
9. Afghan rug or knee rug
10. Machine sewn garment
11. Article featuring hand embroidery
12. Embroidered cushion cover – complete with insert
13. Quilt – May be machine or hand sewn
14. Article featuring patchwork
15. Article featuring embroidered canvas (tapestry) or needlepoint
16. Needlework picture, screen or wall hanging.  
(Other than embroidered canvas, cross stitch or needlepoint).  
May be framed or otherwise mounted.
17. Article featuring cross stitch (to be hung)
18. Hand Made Shopping Bag
19. Apron, any medium
20. Handmade Teddy Bear
21. Dressed doll
22. Soft toy, suitable for small child
23. Pin Cushion
24. Any other article
