POT PLANTS - Pots not to exceed 25cm diameter (unless otherwise stated)

13. Fern, 3 pots (other than Maidenhair)

19. Miniature Garden; must be growing - total area not to exceed 1.3m perimeter

22. 1 pot foliage, variegated (other than fern)
23. 1 pot flowering (other than orchid)
24. 3 pots, foliage, n.n.d. (other than fern)
25. 3 pots, flowering, n.n.d.
26. 1 pot over, flowering over 25cm diameter
27. 1 pot over, foliage over 25cm diameter
28. Pot plant, climbing
29. Pelargonium, Zonal, in bloom, 1 pot
30. 1 Pot - composite
31. Terrarium
32. Plant growing in water (clear container)
33. Tree Seedling, 1 pot. To be raised from a seed within preceding 6 months
34. Potted herbs – single or composite
35. Plant in unusual container single or composite
36. 1 pot n.e.s.(under 25 cm diameter)
